Through a grant from National Science Foundation (DUE-0630857), Seattle Central Community College will award twenty, \$5,000 per year, 2-year scholarships for talented but financially disadvantaged students pursuing degrees in science, mathematics and engineering.

## HOW DO I APPLY?

1. Complete the attached application, also available online at [www.seattlecentral.edu/learn/ONSIGHT](http://www.seattlecentral.edu/learn/ONSIGHT) . **Deadline is November 3, 2006. Incomplete applications will not be considered for awards.**
2. A **ONE-page personal statement describing background and reasons you feel you deserve a scholarship.** Please summarize family and personal background, extracurricular activities, your academic goals and plans for the future. Be sure to also describe why you are majoring in science, mathematics or engineering.
3. All applicants must demonstrate financial need. Complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), available online at [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov) or by calling 1-800-4FED-AID. **Online submittal is encouraged.**
4. All applicants must show previous academic achievement. Attach copies of high school transcripts and unofficial transcripts from all colleges that you have attended to your application. **Transcripts must be attached to the application.**
5. Two recommendations from Seattle Central faculty, counselors/advisors, employers, community leaders, etc (use attached form) – may be handed in separately. Be sure to note contact information of references if handing in recommendations late.
6. Submit the application to the Seattle Central Community College **Science and Mathematics Division Office – SAM 110** between the hours of 8:00 am and 4:30 p.m. or mail to Seattle Central Community College, Science & Mathematics Division – SAM110, Attn: NSF ONSIGHT Scholarship Program, 1701 Broadway, Seattle, WA 98122.

## WHAT ARE THE REQUIREMENTS?

- Full –time enrollment (a minimum of 12 credits) in science, mathematics & engineering degree programs
- United States citizens, nationals, refugee aliens, or permanent resident aliens at the time of application
- Financial need as defined by the US Department of Education rules for need-based Federal financial aid.
- Maintain a 3.0 grade point average
- Agree to participate in mentoring, internships, or other experiences to increase understanding of the workplace and university culture.
